Ayurveda recommends sleeping with the head facing south or southeast, especially for those who tend to be anxious. This healing technique involves the use of essential oils, either in skincare products or in a diffuser. icture a canvas woven in winding alleyways, painted in shades of mists and clouds. Overlay this dreamscape with the ever-present rhythm of a youthful soul strumming a guitar - that's the mood you step into when you enter Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya.

#### **SCENIC GATEWAY**

The airport-side approach to the city will make it abundantly clear that breathtaking mountains and valleys are a common sight here. The expansive Umiam Lake at dusk or dawn, with cascading hillsides in hues of blue, weaves a surreal experience. Nature lovers are in for a treat as they wander about the place, be it the panoramic view at the end of a meandering path to the Laitkor Peak, treading the

#### **NATURE'S MYSTERY**

Root bridges are a staple of traditional Khasi architecture, facilitating daily pedestrian movement. Not just the Nohwet living root bridge at Mawlynnong, one of Asia's cleanest villages, equally picturesque ones can be spotted at Nongbareh, Padu, Sohra and Nongriat, some of which are double-decker root bridges.





#### **FLAVOURS FOR FOODIES**

On the top floor of the Don Bosco Centre, one can taste the diversity of Northeastern cuisines. But the authentic local flavours are in the roadside stalls of momos and jadoh (a rice and meat preparation). Taste a slice of Shillong's teenage nostalgia packed in Jeves' Food Corner, or head to the Red Rice in the bustling Police Bazar for a Khasi thali. For the adventurous, doh snam (blood sausages), exotic meat, and fried silkworms await! Pickles made of fiery chillies, bamboo shoots, and berries are perfect gastronomic souvenirs.



#### **LOCAL INDULGENCE**

The abundance of fruits and berries, such as the *sohiong* (black cherry), in Meghalaya's hills and forests makes for



exceptional homemade wine. Local shops stock affordable fruit wine throughout the year, but the real magic happens at the stalls of spirited local entrepreneurs during Shillong's countless festivals. One insider tip: sip the pocket-friendly Bhutanese Zumzin peach wine.



Best Time to Visit: The most apt time for a trip to Shillong is between February and June, which is when the weather is quite pleasant.

Shillong is around 100 km from Guwahati, Assam. gravel path surrounding Ward's Lake, the exhilarating above-the-clouds escapade at the Laitlum Canyons, or the multitude of gushing waterfalls including the Elephant Falls or the Spread Eagle Falls. For the adventurous, a trek through the Khasi Hills along the verdant David Scott forest trail promises a delightful experience peppered by crystal-clear pools and serene valleys.

While exploring the surrounds on a day road trip, make sure to stop at the iconic Nohkalikai Falls, one of the tallest plunge waterfalls in India, in the lush Sohra region. The ethereal sight of the waters cascading down evergreen hills is straight out of a dream. Not very far away, experience the thrill of adventure at Mawsmai Cave where you can spot fossils, or stop at the scenic Mawkdok for a cup of tea.

In the West Khasi Hills, a few hours from Shillong, you will be awestruck by the beauty of the biggest river island in Meghalaya, Nongkhnum, where you can seek solace as you bask in the sun or go boating or fishing. The island is surrounded by waterfalls and rare biodiversity, and often hosts local festivals.

#### **CULTURAL SYNTHESIS**

Shillong's ubiquitous English architectural influence is epitomised in the forest houses, churches, and educational institutes that dot the city. One of the oldest buildings here is the restored All Saints' Cathedral with striking wooden structures. Equally captivating are the stained glass installations at Cathedral Catholic Church in Laitumkhrah. This oldworld colonial charm thrives seamlessly alongside the flourishing and diverse tribal heritage - the Khasi, Jaintia, and Garo tribes, among others, each with their unique identity,

Visit the tranquil town of Dawki (around 80 km from Shillong) near the India-Bangladesh to witness the crystal-clear Umngot River. As you gasp at the vast expanse of the river, make a stop at the Dawki-Tamabil border crossing, where the army personnel on the other side of the border oblige by posing for photographs. Take a boat ride on the emerald waters of Umngot before you return.





LAND OF PERPETUAL WINDS

Take a trip to the mystical Balpakram, considered the abode of spirits by the local Garo tribe. Explore the foreboding cliffs, jungles and caves in the region. Visit the famed national park here, which is a treasure trove of animal species, including the endangered wild water buffalo.

In the South **Garo hills lies** the mystical **Wari Chora** with towering canyons and a tranquil river flowing through it

festivals, and customs. A stroll at the Don Bosco Centre for Indigenous Cultures is a must to understand the region's cultural heritage. The galleries showcase lifestyle, language, art and culture in detail, with a skywalk panning to a breathtaking 360-degree view of Shillong. Not very far from the capital is what is dubbed 'nature's museum' — the sacred groves of Mawphlang and the abode of the Khasi deity. Take a tour around the village through the monoliths for a peek into the tribal customs and traditions as you soak in the beauty of an enchanting multi-hued lush landscape with a hint of brightly coloured flowers.

On the other side, amidst the West Jaintia Hills, is the cultural and commercial hotspot of Jowai that was once the seat of the Pnar kings. It is an ideal place to encounter local culture besides visiting historical attractions like Syntu Ksiar, the 19th-century Jowai Presbyterian Church, Thadlaskein Lake, lalong Park and the famous Nartiang monoliths. Don't miss the iconic Krangshuri Falls that unveils like a white curtain over a cave, making for a breathtaking view as you descend multiple rocky steps toward it. Also, visit the enchanting Chympe Falls in East Jaintia Hills.

#### RAP, ROCK AND K-POP

Beyond tribal beats, Shillong's modern melody owes a nod to its Christian influence. Growing up singing hymns, kids here pick up Western notes quickly. Homegrown rock bands like Indian Ocean boast global popularity, attracting heavy-hitters like The Scorpions and Michael Learns to Rock for unforgettable



Explore The Craft Collective Cafe & Store for an array of artisanal products, or the Dakti Craft for its exquisite handmade clay and bamboo creations.

# 'HALLYU' hits home

With K-dramas gaining popularity in India, the interest in Korean cuisine has increased manifold. We dig deeper into this new-age trend

ndia's obsession with K-dramas has reached its pinnacle lately. Crash Landing On You and Kim's Convenience, among other shows, became smashing hits during the Covid-19 pandemic, impressing the country's netizens with its brand of romance, comedy and drama. A Netflix report revealed that the viewership of Korean dramas by the Indian audience rose by 370 per cent, between 2019-20.

From K-pop to K-beauty, Korean culture has attained global popularity like never before, reinforcing the 'Hallyu' or the K-wave that has taken the world by storm. It has sparked greater interest in Korean cuisine, with food assuming a 'central' character in most shows and movies. Whether it's a romantic date made special with *bibimbap*, a family bonding over *kimchi* at dinner or a bowl of piping-hot *ramen*, there's something about these dishes that has left the curious diner wanting for more.

While some Korean restaurants have been running in different pockets of the country for a while now, unsurprisingly, this K-craze has translated into a meteoric rise



#### **SWEET TOOTH!**

While Korean cuisine is popular for its spicy flavours, it also has a variety of desserts for food connoisseurs to explore. Try out tteok or Korean rice cakes, hotteok (sweet pancakes), the dalgona candy, which become famous from the web series Squid Game and hwachae or traditional Korean punches.



in their popularity, particularly in Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Chennai and Pune. Gung-The Palace, a Korean restaurant that opened in 2007 in Delhi's Green Park area, can attest to the higher acceptance of this cuisine. Interestingly, its owner Jin Bum Kim's observation and conviction many years ago helped him become a pioneer in this space. "While I was studying at Delhi University, I found that my batchmates loved gimchi (or kimchi) whenever I brought it in my lunchbox or served at a house party. I realised they enjoyed everything spicy and strong, particularly due to the similarities in Indian cuisine," he shares. Soon after, Gung opened in Gurugram in 2010 and in Noida in 2011.

"An increasing population of Indian youngsters are becoming aware of Korean food. Thanks to K-dramas, they want to experiment with our cuisine. Most of them already know of *soju* or Korean wine. They are also gaga about Korean barbecue," adds Kim.

The credit for the growing popularity of Korean cuisine partly goes to 'mukbang' videos as well,

where the host eats unusually large amounts of food. "I am addicted to ASMR 'mukbang' where the host prepares Korean dishes and eats it in front of the audience. Sounds like chewing, chomping and slurping are rather common, making it a sensory experience for the viewer," confesses Neha Sinha, a 32-year-old advertising professional from Bengaluru.

While the obsession with Korean cuisine may have recently gone mainstream, the food was already popular in Northeast India, with its locals preferring similar kind of meat with a hint of spice, says Ankur Sahni, General Manager at Kofuku, a popular Japanese restaurant with outposts in Goa, Leh, Delhi-NCR, and Mumbai that has recently introduced a Korean menu. "Koreans generally enjoy dinner in a community-style setup with friends and family, hence their meals have large portions. Korean banchan (side dishes) is preferred apart from hot pots. Tteokbokki and bibimbap are also big draws for Indians." he mentions.

The commonalities between Korean and Indian cuisine are





#### **BOWL FOR SOUL**

The most searched dish on Google in 2023 is served as a bowl of warm white rice topped with namul (variety of edible grass or leaves) and gochujang (chilli paste). Many prefer to add egg and sliced meat too!

far and few. Chef Amal Farooque, Founder, Sugar Over Dose, Sliders & Fries, and Sage & Olio, in Mumbai, highlights, "Korean cuisine has a lot of red elements—their kimchi and jjigae (Korean stews) are usually reddish-orange. The sweet tangy gochujang and the umami of their soybean paste are palatable by Indians. Their ingredients may not be necessarily similar to the Indian subcontinent but they liberally use gochugaru garlic, onion and sesame in their preparations."

There are also other dishes that reflect the rich culinary tradition of Korea. *K-Benedict*, Korean corn cheese and vegetable pancakes for instance, hold a prominent place in Korean cuisine. "Observations suggest that the preference for

bold and spicy flavours and fermented ingredients are distinctive features of Korean cuisine, contributing to its popularity," Dhruv Oberoi, Chef at The Grammar Room, Delhi, says.

The love for Korean street food is also catching up! The Cafe at Korean Cultural Centre in Delhi and Sibang in Delhi-NCR have frequent visitors for *bingsoo*, a street-food dessert. Other

street foods include crispy Korean fried chicken and corn dog, available at various food joints.


The fascination with K-food is here to stay. "I don't think the obsession is going down anytime soon. Even the older generation is taking interest," Kim emphasises. As gastronomes throng Korean eateries, culinary enthusiasts have taken to whipping up exotic Korean meals at home and not just ramen! For authentic ingredients, they can always fall back on the exclusive Korean grocery stores that have cropped up in different cities. From Seela Mart in Gurugram to Seoul Store in Bengaluru and Uncle's Shop in Mumbai, the shops have abundant varieties of noodles. rice cake, frozen foods, and more.









impact of platforms that can make them distressed.

The actor is riding high with the praise her latest release has garnered. Panday says, "I feel more validated than happy. Not just the fact that I chose to be Ahaana, but also that my character makes those choices in the film. I am happy that people noticed small things that I did in the film and liked them. More than anything, they found comfort in my character."

Talking about the response her latest release has received, the 25-year-old shares, "We are all so much over the moon! It was a very pleasant surprise! What was noteworthy was that despite being on OTT, the response was theatrical - almost everyone saw it at the same time - almost as soon as it was released."

Directed by Arjun Varain Singh, the film delves into the complexities of modern relationships in the era of social media. Speaking about the relatable nature of the narrative, Panday says, "It is very real - how the characters interact, how they spend time, hangout at specific places, and just the way that the world is right now - social media is the fourth character in everyone's life now - and how relationships are being affected in this time. Isn't it very real?"

The young Gen Z cast and crew left no stone unturned in their efforts to make the film seem as real and relatable as possible. Narrating an anecdote while shooting in Goa, Panday says, "In the very first

schedule, we went to Goa to shoot the first song 'Hone Do Jo Hota Hai,' which I actually recorded on my phone. They gave us scooters and sent us to bars and beaches. All of it was actually happening, and I just happened to record all of it on my phone, and we made a song out of it. Isn't that how most of us in this generation live - take life as it comes?"

#### **Personal space**

This is also probably why the actor, with an active presence on social media, is adept at dodging questions on her personal life. Panday has not been exactly revelatory about her relationship with rumored beau actor Aditya Roy Kapoor, but neither has she been coy. 


