

Parents can foster confidence by offering praise for effort and growth, not just



Travelling to discover indigenous cultures has become popular across the world. In India as well, tribal tourism has been gaining ground. On the occasion of World Tourism Day (September 27), here are some journeys you can undertake to explore India's vibrant tribes and their unique lifestyles

ndia's tribal landscape is as varied as the country itself. Spread across the length and breadth of the country, tribal communities live a vibrant life with ancient traditions, art and craft, and cuisines. These indigenous people have a distinct lifestyle that is now triggering a tribal tourism movement.

Madhya Pradesh is home to several tribes. The Bharia tribe lives mostly in and around the Patalkot valley, a densely forested area surrounded by the Satpura range. The valley is rich in herbs and medicinal plants and the Bharia tribe members are known for their knowledge of these herbs. Their food is heavy in forest produces like berries. Their festivals are vibrant filled with music and dances. Another major tribal community, the Gonds, inhabit the forests of the Vindhyas, Satpura and Mandla in the Narmada region. They are best known for their intricate art, which is often seen on the walls of their houses. Today Gond art is popular across India. Another old tribal community, the Baigas, are mostly forest dwellers and live in the Mandla and Balaghat districts. They possess a sound knowledge of the therapeutic properties of trees and herbs and their meals primarily consist of such grains as kodo millet and kutki.

In Bhopal, visit the Tribal Museum for a glimpse of the lifestyle of the seven major tribes in the state — Gond, Bhil, Korku, Baiga, Sahariya, Kol and Bharia — through their crafts.



Tattooing or godna is a traditional art form practised by some tribal communities in Madhya Pradesh. The designs reflect their beliefs and culture.




A mystical land fabled for its brave tribes living amidst verdant mountains, Nagaland is an alluring destination. With unique traditions and customs, the state is home to a number of tribal communities, including the Ao, Angami and Konyak tribes. A tribal trail of Nagaland can start from Mon, the home of the Konyak tribe, once feared as headhunters. Today, they are known for their tattoos and wood carving. During the Aoleang Monyü Festival in April, the tribe turns out in its best traditional finery — shawls, hats, sashes and jewellery.

On the outskirts of capital Kohima, stop at Kisama Heritage village, which offers a glimpse of the Naga tribal lifestyle, especially during the annual Hornbill Festival, usually held in December.

While Warli is a name that instantly connects to a distinctive art form, it is one of the largest tribes of Maharashtra region and lives on the outskirts of Mumbai, in the north Sahyadri area. Walvanda, a small village nestled amidst green paddy fields, is where you can experience the unique culture and art of this tribe. They draw minimalistic geometric forms to depict scenes from daily life in a distinct style. Traditionally, this art was used to decorate their homes on special occasions, but now, it is used for home decor items and has become a source of revenue for the artists. Earlier, a paste of rice was used as paint to draw simple patterns on red-brown walls with a chewed bamboo stick as paint brush.

Married women of the Warli community play a central role in creating *chowk*, their most important painting, to mark special occasions.

A community that traces its roots to Africa, it is said that the Siddis arrived in India centuries ago, may be as agricultural labourers. Today, they reside mostly in Gujarat and over time, have absorbed nuances of the local culture. They are well known for their music and dances, especially the Siddi dhamal, which originally was a celebratory hunting dance. In this unique dance form, male dancers, with their bodies and faces painted, move energetically to drum beats. Artistes performing dhamal are usually viewed with great awe at dance festivals, both in India and abroad. While their meals are heavy in pulses and meats, their spices are a mix of native and Indian flavours. Siddis are known for their hand-stitched quilts, made from colourful fabric pieces.

TRAVEL

The Siddi village of Jambur is a must-visit when you are in Gir National Park, as it is a great way to understand the community and its culture. Most resorts and hotels here arrange cultural evenings dedicated to the Siddi tribe and their dances.





Park is the last refuge of the Asiatic to spot the majestic beast. Alternatively, you can visit the nearby Gir_ Interpretation Zone, an enclosure.



During the *dhamal* dance, the dancers wear a unique belt made of shells and their faces and arms are covered in intricate white designs.







It was also known as thoonga nagaram or the "city that never sleeps", owing to its night markets. Madurai is dedicated to the emerald-tinged Goddess Meenakshi, who according to legends, married Lord Shiva (Lord Sundareswarar) and was given away by her brother This celestial wedding is grandly celebrated every year during the Chithirai Festival. The cultural capital of Tamil Nadu, Madurai exudes a sense of timelessness, tinged with a strong numinous vibe.

But there is more to this Southern city than temples. The grand palace of Nayak dynasty's ruler Thirumalai Nayak, built in the 1600s, still stands near the temple and is inspired by European styles with a blend of other influences. You can't miss the



While idli, dosai and sambar maybe the staple diet in all of Tamil Nadu, Madurai's gastronomic flavours are best experienced as street food. While Murugan Idli Kadai has given a fillip to the humble idli, the street food here is essentially a non-vegetarian's paradise. Kothu parotta and kari dosa with mutton kothu curry is a speciality. Mutton balls called kola urundai is another local favourite. Don't miss bun parotta, mushy idli, golden dosa, idiyappam and sooji appams.

JASMINE AND JIGARTHANDA

The land of jasmine and jigarthanda (a popular local drink) is famous for its bustling markets. You can't miss the famous banana market with around 20 varieties of the fruit. Madurai *malli* or the indigenous jasmine that grows here is the first flower in Tamil Nadu to get a GI tag. The flower markets in the city are a part of its heritage. There is an old pottery village at Vilachery, where artists make beautiful clay dolls, especially for festivals. The city's textile heritage is reflected in the local saree Madurai Sungudi. a beautiful handwoven dream in tie and dye. Madurai is a riot of colours and flavours and you can't leave the city without tasting its quintessential cooling jigarthanda!

Madurai is also a gateway to some of the most popular destinations in both Tamil Nadu and neighbouring Kerala. From hill stations like Kodaikanal and Munnar in the Western Ghats to cultural hotspots like Chettinad and spiritual spots like Rameswaram, there are many destinations to explore around Madurai.


KODAIKANAL

Mulling Over MILLETS

Be it making cakes, kebabs or smoothies, millets can be used to cook a variety of delicacies and not only in the preparation of traditional dishes. As the world celebrates the International Year of Millets 2023, here are some new-age fun recipes to try with this indigenous Indian superfood


he declaration from the United Nations to celebrate 2023 as the International Year Of Millets reiterated what Indians had been practising since ages! It reinforced the advantages these grains have over wheat and rice. India has had a rich tradition of millet consumption, with ancient texts describing their benefits in detail. "Yajurveda has mentions of foxtail and barnyard -dating millet consumption to before the Indian Bronze Age (4500 BC). If you look at the history of India, our traditional foods were baira, jowar and ragi - all millets. Wheat and rice

ORANGE SORGHUM CAKE

A unique cake made with candied orange and orange syrup, this is a guilt-free dessert! In the cake recipe, replace refined flour with *sorghum* (great millet) flour and whole wheat flour. You can also use one portion of jaggery with one portion of sugar. Make a sugar syrup and dip sliced fresh oranges in it. Simmer on low flame to make the candies, cool them. Squeeze the juice of one orange into the balance syrup, boil again to make an orange syrup to be used for drizzling on the baked cake. For the cake, add softened butter, sugar and jaggery powder and make a fluffy mix. Add dry ingredients, a little milk and mix well. Do not over mix. Place the candied orange slices and then pour the cake batter over it. Bake and let it cool. Turn the cake upside down and drizzle the

were introduced in our meals much later," says Chandigarh-based chef Vikas Chawla, who has just launched Jhumroo, a restaurant that serves a millet-intensive menu.

Agrees Gautam Kumar, the executive chef of Moksha Himalayan Spa Resort, Parwanoo, who has been propagating the health benefits of millets to guests at the hilltop wellness property. "Millets ought to be brought back from the godowns of history and onto the tables for everyday meals. Millets are gluten-free and easily absorbed by the body, in addition to being high in fibre, copper, calcium, iron, manganese, phosphorus and magnesium. These are slow to digest and do not induce blood sugar spikes, making them suitable for diabetics. Apart from the numerous health benefits, millets have a distinct flavour that enhances the quality of any food!"

"Ancestral foods like millets are free from modern-day processing and refining methods that help them retain their natural nutrients. A diet based on millets may help prevent hormonal changes in future generations and improve overall health," adds the chef.

KODO BURGER

What if you could eat a burger without thinking about carbs? Here is a burger recipe to help you achieve that! For the kodo millet burger, replace the traditional potato patty with one that is packed with ground millet, watermelon seeds, basil, parsley, coriander, mustard, and cumin. Serve with a zesty chickpea hummus spread over the buns along with lettuce and a mouthwatering tomato salsa on the side!









MILLET PHIRNI

This creamy milk porridge is traditionally made with rice. But rice can easily be replaced with bajra or pearl millet. Start by shallow frying about one cup of millet in a little ghee (clarified butter). Add water and cover to let the millet soften. In a separate pan, boil and reduce milk and add to the cooked millet. Add saffron strands and bring it to a boil. When the millets are cooked through, add sugar and cardamom powder. Stir well! Cook for a short while and set it aside. Serve with a garnish of chopped almonds!

STRAWBERRY, BANANA RAGI SMOOTHIE

Dry roast *ragi* (finger millet) flour in a pan till it emits a strong aroma. Add a little hot water and make a dough like mixture. Soak seedless dates in hot water. In a blender, add strawberries, banana, dates, milk, the cooked ragi and blend to a smooth texture. Serve chilled.

MILLET DAHI KEBAB

This is a dish that will take many by surprise. Take a portion of boiled and mashed potatoes and add hung curd. Spice it up well. Make a mixture of bajra (pearl millet) flour and whole wheat flour, and stir to form a paste using warm water. Take the mixture in hand and shape them into round kebabs. Dip them into the millet flour paste to coat well on all sides. Roll the kebabs in dry roasted bajra and then shallow fry. Serve with mint chutney.

The many advantages of millets include easy storage, as

compared to other cereals as they have the ability

to preserve themselves for 10 to 12 years. Millet agriculture is, therefore, conscious agriculture. Millet cultivation is environment-friendly. Growing millet does not require extensive use of fertilisers, pesticides and farm equipment.

There are around 10 types of millets available today, including Finger millet,

Foxtail millet, Sorghum, Pearl millet and Amaranth. Finger millet, also known as *ragi*, is rich in calcium and it may prevent bone diseases, such as osteoporosis. Foxtail millet, also known as *kakum* or *kangni*, is another popular millet and is rich in nutrient value, particularly Vitamin B12. Pearl millet or *bajra* is equally favoured in Indian kitchens and helps in curing stomach ailment.

For those who feel cooking millets is a task and can only be used in traditional recipes of rotis and upmas, chef Kumar says, "Millets are the most versatile and can be easily cooked to make delicious dishes, including new-age preparations like smoothies and pancakes!" You can use them to make biryanis and kebabs as well.

SpiceJet Net Profit jumps 126% to INR 205 Crore in Q1 FY2024 as against a loss of INR 789 Crore in Q1 FY2023

Maintains strong performance in passenger business - highest industry domestic load factor of 90%, with an operating revenue at INR 2,002 Crore

Net Profit jumps 104% to INR 17 Crore in Q4 FY2023 as against a loss of INR 458

Crore in Q4 FY2022

SpiceJet reports a Net Profit of INR 205 Crore for the quarter ending June 2023, an increase of 126% as compared to the Net Loss of INR 789 Crore in Q1 FY2023 owing to a strong demand for air travel in India.

For the same comparative period, operating expenses were INR 1,291 Crore as against INR 2,072 Crore. On an EBITDA basis, profit was INR 525 Crore for the reported quarter against a loss of INR 393 Crore for the quarter ending June 30, 2022. Total operating revenue for the reported quarter was INR 2,002 Crore as against INR 2,457 Crore in the same quarter of the previous year.

SpiceJet lowered its Net Loss to INR 1,503 Crore in FY2023 compared to INR 1,725 Crore in FY2022. For the same comparative period, SpiceJet reported operating revenue of INR 8,869 Crore in FY2023 as against INR 6,557 Crore in FY2022. SpiceJet completed the hive-off of its logistics platform into a separate entity, SpiceXpress and Logistics Private Limited effective April 1, 2023.

Consequent to the hive-off there is an improvement of net worth in SpiceJet to the tune of INR 2,557 Crore (from negative INR 4,288 Crore to negative INR 3,232 Crore i.e. positive variance by 25%).

Ajay Singh, Chairman and Managing Director, SpiceJet, said, "I am happy that despite facing multiple challenges, we have posted a profit in Q1 FY2024. Our team's relentless efforts and dedication and the continuous support from our valued customers have been pivotal in this success. I firmly believe in the potential of our airline, and I am pleased to have contributed to its growth by infusing INR 500 Crore into the company. This infusion

will help bolster our efforts in reviving our grounded planes, for which we have been working tirelessly, strengthening our fleet and expanding our cargo operations."

"Our logistics arm continues to soar. It's exceptional performance, with sustained profits, has been a driving force, contributing to our overall success. We remain focused on adapting to the changing landscape of the aviation industry, identifying and seizing new opportunities, and steering our airline towards greater heights."

In terms of operational parameters, SpiceJet had the highest passenger load factor amongst all airlines in the country. The average domestic load factor was 92% for the March 2023 quarter and 88% for FY2023. SpiceJet had the highest load factor of 90% in O1EY2024

What is the best thing that you like about the place?


The best thing about Kerala is its great flora. There are massive, green expanses is like heaven on earth, if you ask me, and




Why do you like Salkara so much?
